How do I turn in financial contributions?

- Credit card donations can be made via the phone at 970-493-4477, through our website (see below) or turned in through a food drive envelope or on a 2-part receipt.
- Checks can be turned in with total collections, or mailed directly to the Food Bank at 1301 Blue Spruce, Fort Collins CO, 80524.
- Cash donations can be turned in with total collections, or may be dropped off at the address above. Please do not mail cash. If a donor would like a receipt for a cash donation, they must include their name, address and total donated and one will be mailed to them. Drivers picking up for the Food Fight are not encouraged to pick up monetary donations, but if necessary please make sure that all contents are secured in a sealed envelope that is properly labeled with all contact information.

Why donate online?

- Donating online is fast, easy, environmentally friendly and, fun! If you would simply like to make a donation, go to www.foodbankklarimer.org/donate and click donate now. Where it says how did you hear about us, enter your company or organization name.
- For those who like the experience of purchasing food to donate, supporters can see online how much they can buy with our purchasing power and the Virtual Food Drive is easy to share with friends, family and co-workers. Visit our website and go to food drives where you will see the Virtual Food Drive link. Do your shopping and then head to the check-out page and select your company name from the drop-down menu.

Will donors receive a tax receipt for their donation?

- Yes! Each donor will receive an acknowledgement letter by mail, provided we receive the following at the time the donation is turned in:
 - Donor name, complete address, donation amount and gift date.

Many corporations have a matching gift program. Please consult with your HR department or national affiliate to see if your company matches charitable contributions to the Food Bank. When making a contribution that your company will match, be sure to enclose the paper work required by your company with the gift.
